

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- → The ILO Intranet web site works like a "hat" over existing Departmental web pages
- → Its main role is to index Departmental web pages
- → The Departmental web sites indexed belong to the Intranet and the Public area
- → The Departmental web site pages are manually produced and maintained by web editors inside each Department







→ The ILO Intranet layer gives access to the Departmental web pages by means of:

→ Browsing methods

- →A hierarchical classification system by topic and subtopics
- →An alphabetical index
- → The list of all ILO working units





User interface

Departmental pages: the common header





→ For the Departmental layer

- → Departmental Web sites are mainly done by STATIC WEB PAGE
- → A Static page is a file stored in a file system
- → Each file/page is manually created and updated by Departmental web editors
- → The web site results to be a simple collection of files physically stored in a directory.

→ For the Intranet layer

- **→** Each page belonging the the Intranet layer is a DYNAMIC WEB PAGE
- → The content of a Dynamic web pages comes from a Database (Oracle 9)
- → The web pages are generated by means of software components (PL-Sql).
- → These components interface with the Database, querying it in order to extract and lay out the data, thus producing the page.

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Goals of the redesign project

Constraints

- → It is planned, in the future, to use the WCMS technology also for the Intranet, so as consequence:
 - → The ILO Intranet continue to work like a "hat" over existing Departmental web pages
 - → The Departments continue to produce and maintain their own Web site using the current technology (static pages stored in file system)
 - → For the Intranet layer, the attempt is to reuse the current implementation technology as much as possible



Goals of the redesign project

New needs

- → Enhance Intranet's functions and provide more content in order to make it work as a knowledge and operating tool for the ILO staff, by:
 - → Providing more information to ILO staff, for their daily work as well as for their leisure time
 - → Giving more space to those Departments providing Services and Support to ILO Staff
 - → Improving the mechanism of providing more News to ILO staff
 - → Pushing or highlighting specific content



Goals of the redesign project

New needs

- → "Elect" the Intranet as the preferred media for the dissemination of internal information coming from Management
- → Revise the graphic aspect of the user interface

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Project guidelines

What it was decided

- → Redefine the five main areas indexing the Departmental web sites
- → Reorganize the hierarchical classification system
- → Redesign the Home page
- → Create a new second level page used by the Departments to provide News or highlight information




The five new main areas

1. HRD & Administration	Practical information from the HRD department			
2. Services	Information from various management and support services of the ILO			
3. Information Resources	A compilation of various sources of information, databases, and other work-related resources			
4. Lifestyle in HQ	A compilation of practical information sources that might make life in HQ and Geneva a little be easier and a little more fun			
5. HQ and field offices	Information and direct links to the various ILO Offices, Departments, and Programmes

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The concept

→ The idea is to move from a text oriented user interface, typical of Intranet user interface, to a most attractive style, something closer to the "brochure" style



The Graphic user interface

Features of user interface

- → Minimum page/screen dimension visualization: 800x600 pixels
- → Fonts resizable by the user in order to aid people with vision deficiencies
- → Same appearance of colors on screen:
 - → with 256 colors
 - → with thousands/millions colors
- → Low "weight" of pages:
 - → Using as few images as possible
 - → Optimizing the HTML code
